

EOC Reminders!

RETURN ALL WORK, Workbooks, Binders, ect.. – MAKE SURE STUDENTS CHECK EMAILS & GRADES – LAST DAY FOR TUTORING!

1.) **Yellow Work Folder** – look over class website where all ideas are on EOC Practice/Study! Look over Chapter Summaries & Quizlet & From the Videos as you watch them! You will turn this in on Friday for a grade. *Remember you have graph paper on the back, you can start as soon as you have it, ask for more!

*Show you the trick for Rotations on Graph paper!

2.) **Calculators** – make sure it's on degree (DRG) – make sure you use the 2nd button for trig angles (practice & rounding to the nearest tenth, hundredth, and degree) *always use your calc at least 2,3 times to make sure you get the same answers.

3.) **Questions** - Try to do each question two different ways and plug in to check answers – even if they don't ask for the extra. Answer every question! When answering Questions it is progressive/adaptive test – which means you must do your very best on each question as you go (especially the first 5-8 or so) – do not skip, guess, and then go back – this determines your rest of your test questions. If you don't do well on the first ones it will be very difficult to get a 3 and pass because you won't get those questions that will allow you to reach that level. Of course, once you are finished with the session you can go back and check answers or change answers – but make sure you try your best first to get the correct answer before moving on.

4.) **ONE NOTE** – look over Notes on yours and mine on Content Library – I added ALL Circles Notes with ALL answers (make sure to look over these – there's some that have FOIL/Factoring). Look at the Vocab folder/ quizlet / test folder – all of it!

5.) **TEAMS** – check the general page for any activities we did that may help to review

6.) **TESTS** & Test Corrections that you did all year! Review it!

7.) **Interactive Journals** – go over all the activities we have done – especially constructions, foldables, and so on..

8.) **Class Website:** Geometry EOC Practice/Study *added links at the bottom - check those out! Look at Geometry 24/25 added the answer keys there too. Look back at previous years Geometry some of the answers for the first packet the item tasks are there (they just may not be in order or may be missing some quest) Look over Chapter summaries too! *MAKE SURE TO WATCH THOSE VIDEOS!

9.) **Everything is open** – McGraw Hill, ALEKS, PearAssessment, Gizmos, Desmos, ect. If anything you need is not open please let me know.
