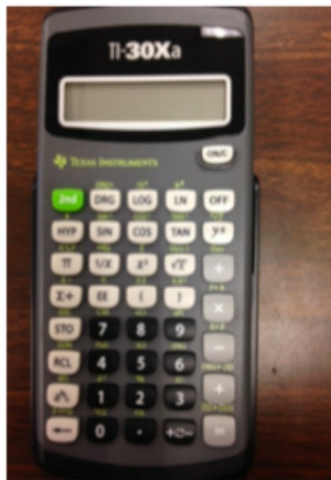

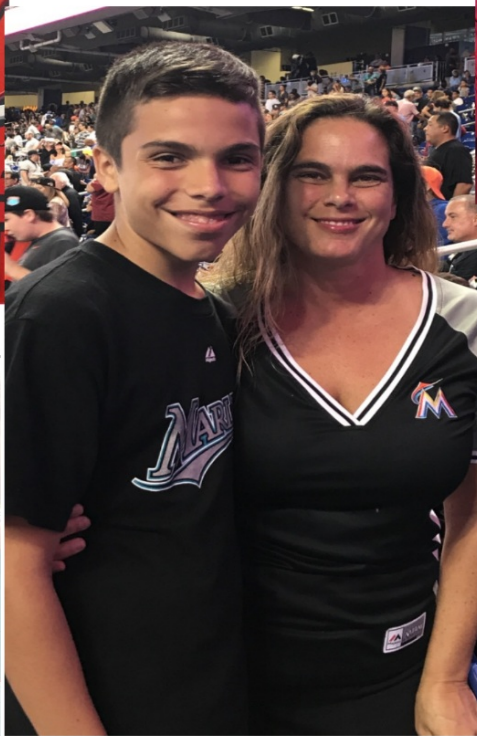

## Venn Diagrams for Partners

**Hand out paper & color pencils**

Have your students break up into pairs. Pass out pre-made [Venn diagram](#) templates. Give your students 10-15 minutes to fill in their Venn diagrams with

things they and their partner do and do not have in common. Then, have each pair present their Venn diagram to the class.

Whichever of these ice breaker activities or games you choose, your students will have fun, get to know each other, and feel much more comfortable in your classroom.



**Think Fast** - Give students a few minutes and tell them to learn all the names they can. Then split the group into teams. Have one student from each team write as many names the group can remember on dry erase boards. Give the team with the most names a prize!
